Dear Stewart Elementary Parents/Guardians:

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) requires school districts to notify parents of the requirements of the Public Education Grant (PEG) Program authorized under *Texas Education Code*, Chapter 29, Subchapter G, §§29.201 - 29.205. Effective for the 2021-2022 school year, the PEG list identifies campuses that received an F rating in both the Student Achievement and the School Progress domains in 2019 accountability. Due to COVID-19, TEA has repeated the prior year list and kept Stewart Elementary on the PEG list.

As the parent or guardian of a student attending a campus identified on the PEG list, you have the option to request a transfer of your child to another elementary campus in Huntsville Independent School District not on the PEG list or request a transfer of your child to a campus in another school district for the 2021-2022 school year. If you apply for transfer to a neighboring school district, the district chosen is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in that district, but may not use criteria that discriminate on the basis of a student's race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex or socioeconomic status. If the application is accepted, the school district chosen may not charge the student tuition. The home school district does not have to pay for transportation charges to and from school.

The Stewart Elementary staff is committed to the success of every student.
